

DISCOURS DIRECT ET INDIRECT



Discours direct : Paroles exactes, entre guillemets. Ex :
He says, "I am happy."

Discours indirect : Paroles rapportées. Ex : He says that he is happy.



Si le verbe d'introduction est au présent, le temps ne change pas dans le reste de la phrase.



S'il est au prétérit on applique la concordance des temps.

Présent → Prétérit :

"I like pizza." → He said he liked pizza.

Présent continous → Prétérit continous :

"I am eating." → He said he was eating.

Prétérit → Past perfect :

"I saw the movie." → He said he had seen the movie.

Present perfect → Past perfect :

"I have finished." → He said he had finished.
